Let's go fly a Kite

Learn to soar by making your own kite!


1. Go hunting for two straight sticks no thicker than 1cm in thickness.

2. Cut out your kite template in your kite kit. Then attach your two sticks with tape to the two vertical dottened lines marked 2. Snap off any excess stick.

3. Stick some tape over the two corners marked 3 on the template and then make a hole through each of the circles. Thread your string through the first hole securing with a knot and then pass it along the dotted horizontal line and secure through the other hole.





4. Finally, attach the string of your handle halfway along the horizonal string on your kite template at the point marked X. Then add ribbons as tails and decorate with your craft kit.

Find a breezy spot, hold your kite in one hand and the handle in another, release the string to about 5m and then run! Let go of your kite and watch it soar. Continue to let out string to make it go higher and higher!
