We are writing to advise you that your child has been selected to participate in an exciting, new and personalised programme in school, called My Wild Life.

The programme links children's feelings and emotions with the natural world and the key themes in the school curriculum.

It is aimed at supporting your child's growth and development and to meet their needs through fun and engaging activities improving social and emotional skills.

HOW THE Programme WORKS

Your child will be given their own personalised kit of resources, an individual workbook and journal and together with the course leader in school, will work through different activities to support their own personal development.

The kits encourage children to explore outside the classroom, and they will often be asked to collect items to help them complete activities and tasks in the kits. Looking for natural items such as interesting flowers, leaves, shells or feathers, to make their activity more individual to them.

Each kit has a theme, such as Confidence, Change, Strength and Friendships and the kits all have a story that runs through the activities, enabling your child to explore the topic in more details through the story and the characters in it.

We really hope that your child shares what they are learning during their participation in the programme and they may well bring items home that they have made or created which hopefully will also help to prompt conversations.

You can also join in additional activities with your child and any siblings by completing any of the additional suggested activities at home, or by following Wild for Life on social media or signing up for the newsletter, which contains lots of information about activities that you can easily do out of school by exploring local green spaces.
